At this point in the internship, I have mainly focused on research and getting familiar with the career and educational life of August and Irma Cook. I have not focused my research on anything specific yet because I am simply documenting any and all information I can find about August and Irma Cook on the internet and various clippings of newspapers I can find that were published during that time that include August Cook.

I have also been able to see the paintings that are going to be included in the show and have categorized them loosely around what exhibit labels I want to be near them. However, now that I have read more about exhibit labels, I see that this will be more of a museum of August and Irma's life, rather than a regular art exhibition. The chairs will actually fit in well because they will give the viewer the experience of seeing August and Irma as real people, rather than artists that they do not know. Overall the experience thus far has been enjoyable with researching August and reading about curating and all the different types of exhibit labels that need to be utilized at various times. The beginning of this internship has been slow because the show is not supposed to go up until the beginning of the Fall semester, but I am excited to plan it, do my research, and eventually help set up the show!
