- ____/10 Pts Rendered Floor Plan, shown to scale ($\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{4}$ " Graphic Scale) indicating a spatial application to shaping the interior space to fit the client's Lifestyle.
- ____/20 Pts Detailed Drawings a
 - (3) minimum Kitchen Details.
 - ____/10 Pts. Enlarged plan of detail to $\frac{1}{2}$ " scale (Graphic Scale for Presentation). Stacking Diagram is the exception (no plan view).

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- ____/10 Pts. Annotations for products with arrows indicating materials and finishes being used in the construction of detail.
- ____/5 Pts. **Extra Credits - Dimension both Plan View Elevation. Stacking Diagram will be the exception to dimensioning but must note floor and ceiling heights.**
- (2) minimum Master Bathroom Details
 - ____/10 Pts. Enlarged plan of detail to ½" scale (Graphic Scale for Presentation). Stacking Diagram is the exception (no plan view).
 - ____/10 Pts. Annotations for products with arrows indicating materials and finishes being used in the construction of detail. Stacking diagrams must be annotated with arrows indicating what the various areas are being presented
- ____/5 Pts. **Extra Credit - Section for stacking Diagram in addition to (3) Kitchen and (2) Bathroom Elevations**
- ____/20 Pts Minimum - (5) Perspective Drawings giving a comprehensive insight into the overall conceptual designs
 - Rendering can vary, but most of the Perspectives must be rendered.
 - Annotations with Arrows Identifying area - Can be done in PowerPoint.
 - Students can apply creative presentation techniques to communicate project intent.
- ____/10 Pts Minimum - (4) Elevations giving a comprehensive insight to areas not indicated through Perspectives.
 - Annotations with Arrows Identifying area – Can be done in PowerPoint.
 - Students can apply creative presentation techniques to communicate project intent.
- ____/20 Pts Finish and Fabric Selections shall be integrated within the project in an aesthetic manner left to the student's deaccession and design process.
 - Annotations for products indicating materials and finishes being used in the construction of detail
 - The type of Item (i.e., Floor Finish, Seating, Wall Finish, etc.)
 - The location where the Item is to be used (i.e., Lobby, ADA Guest Room, Restaurant, etc.)
 - Item information
 - An arrow pointing to the Item in the rendering or floor plan indicates where these items are located.

Note that Students are also required to submit Revit Drawing Separately. For non-submissions, a reduction in the overall presentation grade will be assessed.

- ____/10 Pts 8. Accessories Info and Photo, (i.e., Lamps, areas rugs, Artwork, or collections)
