

Title Self-Portrait Collage Dates _____ Grade 10th

Objectives:

After the instruction, the students will be able to give an example of an artist that used collage

After the demonstration, the students will be able to explain what a collage is accurately.

After the instruction, students will be able to create a self-portrait using collage techniques.

Materials:

Paper, pencils, erasers, magazines, various types of paper, yarn,
Buttons, scissors, glue, tape

Procedures:

Beginning:

Before class, materials for the project will be placed in bins at the front of the classroom.

Upon entering the classroom, the students will see pictures of collage art pieces.

The students will then be shown a PowerPoint containing information about different artists and artworks that used a collage technique.

After the PowerPoint, the teacher will show examples of previous students work on making collages and give a mini demon on how to create the collage self-portrait.

Middle:

Students will be given paper and instructed to draw out their images first before gluing paper together to create the collage. The drawing will just be a basic outline to guide where certain pieces of paper should go.

After drawing their images students will be given materials to start creating their collage.

End:

Students will put collages on the drying rack and begin cleaning up. (putting magazines and paper away and washing hands and wiping tables if needed)

After clean up students will be informally assessed by asking to give an example of an artist that used collage and explain what collage is.
