



Assignment 05 - Create Detailed Elevations for Kitchen and Bathrooms, Built-ins, and any Specialty Items that may need detailing as the Elevator finishes.

Objective: To allow students to clearly understand how interior objects are detailed and finished along with visual awareness of scale and proportions.

Utilizing the newly constructed Floor Plan, generate detailed Elevations for the Kitchen and Bathroom area along with any specialty Items that may need to be detailed. Be sure to include the following:

- ____ 5pts. 1/2" scaled plan of the specific areas being delineated or detailed with Dimensions.
- ____ 5pts. Elevation symbols of every Elevation being presented. Minimum (3) Elevations for the kitchen, (3) for the Bathroom, and any other elevations necessary for built-in cabinetry and specialty Items.
- ____ 5pts. Elevation Symbols are to be referenced on Plan View for every Elevation constructed, and all individual Elevations should be labeled with Type of Elevation and Drawing Reference Number. See the example sheet for reference.
- Detailed Elevations should include but are not limited to:
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. All Appliances
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. All Plumbing fixtures
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. All countertops
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. All Mirrors
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. All Lighting
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. Wall Finish/Wall Tiling/Backsplash/Moldings
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. Cabinet Finish
 - ◆ ____ 5pts. Specialty Items like the Elevator should note interior finishes and details to include a panel for operation.
- ____ 5pts. Do not forget the Vent Hood.
- ____ 5pts. Do not forget Door and Drawer Pulls (handles)
- ____ 5pts. Remember that the Ceiling Height in the kitchen area may be either lower or higher than in other areas... Watch out for the Upper Cabinets' height, so they do not become too long. If you go to the ceiling with your cabinet, there should be a row of cabinets at the top for storing kitchen items or displaying items.
- ____ 5pts. Remember to show the shelving and what is displayed inside if you use Glass doors.

- _____ 5pts. The height between the countertop and bottom of the upper cabinet is 18"...
- _____ 5pts. All cabinets that rest on the floor must have a Toe Kick of 4" high and 3" deep (Base of Cabinet).
- _____ 5pts. Use Specification for Appliances to show exact size.

 - viii. _____ 1pts. Initials of the person checking the drawings for any mistakes (i.e., Instructors initials)
 - ix. _____ 1pts. Name and Logo and contact information of your firm creating these drawing sets.
 - x. _____ 1pts. Please do not forge the North Arrow.
