


Cato & Ricco Ricco Kitchen


Conceptual Design Inspiration



David Cato and his partner currently live in a charming home that was first built in 1939. The home is currently 5,120 square feet with plenty of room for guests and entertaining. Despite the home's large size, the kitchen is too small and cramped for multiple people to use at a time. They have a small butler's kitchen that they are wanting to expand into the current covered carport area. Mr. Cato is an entertainer and hosts large gatherings multiple times a year. Mr. Cato is an antique collector and has a sophisticated style. He would like a built in bar area that is somewhat separate from the kitchen, a large island (at least 8 feet) for seating purposes only, full length cabinetry, and contain built in appliances. The bar will be in the current location of the butler's kitchen and his kitchen appliances will be in the current carport location. His home is currently in a Victorian style with a little bit of a modern twist, so keeping the historical, light, and airy feeling into the new kitchen is very important, which is why the windows will have the same design that the carport has. The carport will remain at a lower level because Mr. Cato wishes to keep the original character of the carport ceiling.








Pantry/Bar

- Fireplace separates renovated area and living area











