Standards & Objectives

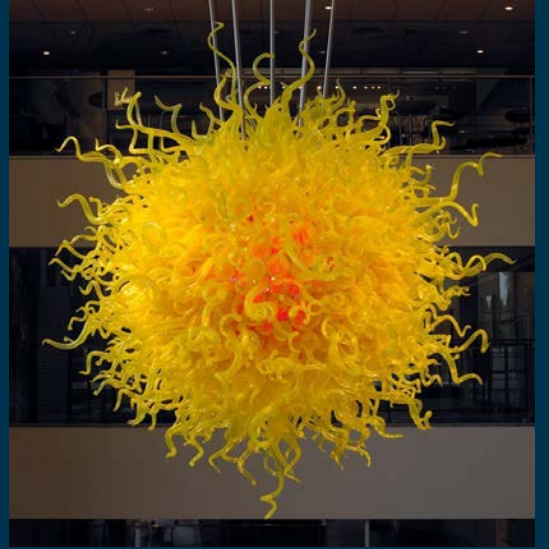
- VA.CR NH. 1 (Benchmark) – I can select and arrange the elements to demonstrate principles of art.

- Students will be introduced to the artist Chihuly and will perform further research on him to better their understanding of the project.
- Students will look through examples of Chihuly's works and design their own version of a Chihuly using plastic bottles, sharpies, and hot glue.

Who is Chihuly?

- Born 1941, in Tacoma, Washington.
- Studied Interior Design at Washington University.
- After graduating in 1965, he went on to apply for a glass program at the University of Wisconsin.
- He continued his studies at Rhode Island School of Design, where he established a glass program and taught there for over a decade.
- His work is included in more than 200 museums.









Project

- Create your own version of a Chihuly chandelier using plastic bottles, sharpies, and hot glue.
- There are plenty of examples online and in this presentation to use as inspiration.
- Start collecting plastic bottles!
- Sketch an idea of what you want the chandelier to look like.
