Students can use recycled materials from home for palettes, mixed media, etc.

I have about \$280 that I can set aside and use for anything else I may need during the school year.

2. Classroom management:

- Students will need to raise their hand to ask for permission for anything, unless instructed otherwise.
- Students entering the room are expected to stay silent and sit in their seat. They will need to work on whatever I have on the board or what I verbally tell them to do. There may be a warmup for them to complete.
- Students exiting the room are expected to stay silent and walk out in an orderly fashion.
- Starting work for the day: students are expected to stay at a low volume and begin working on what they left off on.
- Clean up: Students will clean up when told to do so. This will be expected to be a low volume task. Everything should be put back to where it came from.
- Restroom: I will let students go to bathroom when needed. I will hand out a bathroom pass, and students will need to fill out a time sheet.
- Student work will be stored in individual folders/portfolios. These will be stored in a cabinet, flat file, or drawer by class. Each of my classes will be organized in order throughout the day (1st block, 2nd block, 3rd block, etc.). If work is wet and needs to dry, students can use the drying rack.

3. Rules/consequences:

- Come into the classroom quietly and get started on work.
- Students will always be expected to remain at an indoor-level voice, I will ask up to three times for student to be quiet, after the third time, I will give detention, reduced recess time, etc. (depends on what grade).
- Students are expected to stay seated, unless they need to ask a question, get supplies, or if students must get up for the current project. If the student doesn't comply with these rules, I will have to contact parents about their behavior.
- Leave the classroom quietly and in a mannerly order.
- Most consequences will be detention. If the student decides that they do not want to follow rules or directions, or is disruptive to the class, they will be sent to the principal/ I will be in contact with parents.
